

### Faeces Sample in Jar with SAF Solution

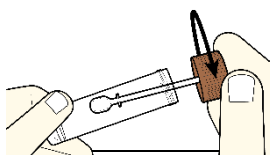
#### THIS IS WHAT YOU NEED

The jars given to you by your care provider. Collection paper or a thoroughly cleaned vessel. The liquid in the jar is not dangerous if used normally. If you get it on your skin, rinse with plenty of water. Adhere to the sample-taking intervals prescribed by your care provider.

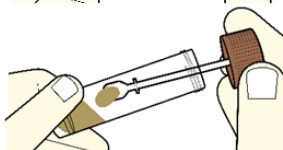
#### HOW TO DO IT



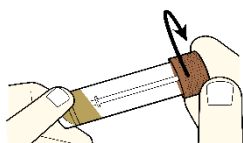
Collect faeces on a paper or in a thoroughly cleaned vessel. If the stool is firm, samples are to be taken both from the outside and the inside of the firm stool.



Unscrew the lid from the small jar. The jar contains SAF solution which should stay in the jar. A spoon is attached to the lid.



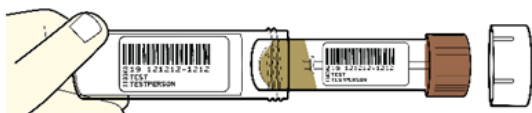
Use the spoon to transfer faeces to the small jar. **Fill a quarter of the jar** with faeces.



Carefully screw the lid back on to the small jar.



Label **both** jars with your full name, personal identity number, and the date and time at which the sample was taken. Use the labels given to you by your care provider.



Place the small jar in the big jar and screw on the lid.



Hand in the sample to your care provider on the same day as the sample was taken at the latest. Transport the sample in a plastic bag of ice. Bring valid ID.
