

Patient fees

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| Sampling..... | SEK 0 |
| Visits to healthcare centres and hospitals..... | SEK 200 |
| Visits to emergency rooms | SEK 400 |

- You will not have to pay if you are under 20 or over 85 years old.
- You pay the same fee for a booked remote visit (chat, telephone and video calls).
- Some visits are free of charge, such as mammograms and visits to paediatric and maternal healthcare services.

Please cancel the visit if you cannot make it

You must cancel your visit at least 24 hours before your booked time, otherwise you will be charged a fee of SEK 400. This also applies to free visits.

High-cost protection and free care

There is a limit to how much you need to pay for visits over a period of 12 months. This is called high-cost protection. Once you have paid SEK 1,450, all visits are free of charge until 12 months after your first paid visit.

Payment

You can pay by card on the premises or by invoice. There is an additional invoicing fee of SEK 50 if you pay by invoice. Some businesses also offer payments by Swish.

Other

The fees apply from January 1 2026, and for those who are registered in Sweden or have an EU card.
